






IZMIT ORTAOKULU








LACEWORK (TURKISH OYA)

Lacework (Turkish oya), also known edging, which appears all over Anatolia in various forms and motifs.








EMBROIDERY

We have painted plates with traditional motifs to give our partners as a memory of our project.



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






• We have prepared a corner with our traditional handicrafts or objects.
